I have worked in the Los Angeles/Valley areas since 1986, saying that to let you know I am very familiar with canyons and areas served by the JPA/LVMVVD.

Murals can be decorative, and more often serve as a tool for communication, such as this project. For decades I have created community murals, and murals for institutions, businesses and schools that serve to beautify and inform. My background is classical- academic fine art; mural painting skills were originally honed as a display artist, and in entertainment /media art departments. The majority of my projects have been collaborations-with art partners, design teams, art directors, with engineers or administration, youth, or the group of artists I am leading. Collaboration brings out the best in me.

In the past 20 years, the focus has been on art that serves and involves the community directly-working with marginalized communities, underserved and incarcerated youth, schools, housing authorities, and private clients, My portfolio and bio demonstrate a variety of styles and experiences, as I respond, creatively, to the conditions and agenda at hand, rather than a set style or approach. This project intrigues and appeals to me.

As a resident of a coastal town, recently ravaged by fires (I have been spared, so far), I am keenly aware of water as a precious resource. This will not be the first project I have done that focused on our place as humans, in the natural world, and our responsibility to preserve the resources that we ourselves depend on for life.

I would welcome collaborating with experts and staff to have this mural best reflect the intentions and important work of the Pure Water Project.

MB Hanrahan: submission

Pure Water Project/Demonstration Center Mural concept: Written description Style and General use of color Lump Sum Budget, reflecting all expenses. (in separate envelope)

Starting in the upper left hand corner-the story of water which is finite: in its condensed form as clouds, and as liquid form-rain and frozen form-snow:

melted snow runs off in streams.

- Rain and runoff are collected in a lake/creek or natural reservoir.
- Silhouettes of catfish, bluegill, mackerel and kelp bass (indigenous fish species)
- = the indigenous Las Virgenes landscape soaks up the water
- blue colored water veins represent underground aquifers
- -a mountain lion (extremely endangered species) laps water. Pollinating insects hover near water and plants.
- -Above the cougar is the silhouette of a hummingbird taking nectar from a flower. Inside this shape, outlined in the same blue green color as the lake water is a deep space view of the universe the earth, stars, other planets-this emphasizes how life on earth is dependant on water. The lake morphs into a blue green ribbon.

This ribbon will demonstrate the water purification process-from waste water to potable water-with simplified symbols: of houses and business warehouses with brown murky water flow coming out; of a screen removing solids, to a paddle removing oils and floating contaminants, to the addition of chlorine and chemicals to remove chlorine taste to clean water pouring out of a spigot into a glass held by a hand..the words Pure Water will subtly create the water shape in the glass. I would obviously have to work with engineers at the plant to accurately depict these steps

To the left of the glass are 3 silhouettes, outlined in blue green water- color, the form of a person working at a desk; ; the form of a person picking a crop, the form of a baby being held up. These shapes will hold images of California water usage:

Business: cloth manufacture, energy production, mining, gas extraction, cattle/livestock (not limited to and including other examples.food, drink manufacturing

Agriculture: irrigation, California crops: beans, citrus, avocados, nuts, alfalfa, flowers, (not limited to, and including other examples.)

Everyday living (baby): tooth brushing, laundry, food prep, hygiene (5 min shower), sanitation, water sports, washing pets (not limited to, and inclusive of other examples)


