
LAS VIRGENES "BACKBONE" WATER SYSTEM

The Backbone System Supplies Everyone

Calabasas, Hidden Hills, Agoura Hills, Westlake Village, West Hills area, and adjacent areas.



- Backbone Improvements
- (1) Phase 1 Agoura & Calabasas Pipeline Expansion
- (2) Phase 2 5 Million Gallon Water Storage Tank
- (3) Phase 3 Westlake Filtration Plant Expansion
- (4) Phase 4 Westlake Pump Station Upgrades

To address storage deficiencie and accommodate projected summertime demands – the "backbone" system is undergoing a multi-project improvement program that includes the Five Million



The District's water system:

- Supports service to all 70,000 customers and subsystems
- Provides water and pressure for fire flow, domestic service and emergency supply
- Allows the District to move water west from the main connection with Metropolitan Water District in Calabasas AND/OR east from Las Virgenes Reservoir to meet changing system needs and demands

The LVMWD service area includes 122 square miles in Los Angeles County and provides drinking water to about 70,000 residents.



• Is described as a "backbone" system because of the main line that serves as the critical "spine" of the water system
