CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC

Construction traffic is expected to increase by only one to five percent depending on time of day. The District will implement a number of steps to further reduce potential impacts to area residents.

- ① Fixed construction hours: 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. (no anticipated weekend activities)
- ② No truck idling or parking on Three Springs Drive
- ③ Excavated soil to remain on-site; no off-site trucking
- ④ Heavy construction deliveries scheduled while children are in school
- ⑤ Access road to be paved, limiting dust



SITE EXCAVATION

Blasting will be performed in a strictly controlled manner to minimize disturbance and to ensure site safety.

- ① Blasting hours: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- ② Independent professional to perform pre- and post-blast surveys
- ③ Construction manager on-site to serve as public liaison
- ④ All blasts covered with heavy mats
- ⑤ Blast areas watered to control dust
- ⑥ Ground motion and air pressure monitored



As part of this design phase, the District is detailing measures intended to minimize construction impacts and inconvenience.
