**Mureau Road Subject to Overnight Closure
Beginning January 21**

(CALABASAS, CA January 15, 2014) Pipeline construction along Mureau Road in Calabasas will make it necessary for overnight traffic closures on a segment of that roadway from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Friday beginning January 21. The section of road to be closed lies between Crummer Road to the west and Round Meadow Road to the east.

“We apologize for any inconvenience during the construction period,” said David W. Pedersen, LVMWD’s General Manager. “However, the two-lane section of Mureau Road has hills and curves that make it a challenge under normal conditions. Shifting the construction work to overnight hours for that section will help speed up the project while protecting workers, pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists.”

Construction crews have been installing a 30-inch pipeline along Mureau Road for several weeks in the four-lane section of that roadway. As the project moves into the two-lane section, night time work is necessary to avoid lengthy backups that would occur if construction was conducted during daytime hours.

Concurrently, there will be intermittent work along Las Virgenes Road.

The overnight work is expected to conclude in late February, weather permitting.
