

Improve Irrigation Efficiency

Nearly **70%** of the water delivered to LVMWD customers is used for irrigation.



As much as **50%** of water we use for landscaping is wasted due to inefficient watering methods and systems.

Slow the Flow

Install drip irrigation or rotary nozzles that distribute water at a lower rate, delivering precise coverage to plants and reducing runoff.



Adjust is a Must

Check sprinklers periodically to ensure they are properly positioned and not watering walls or sidewalks.



A Sensor is Better

Install a weather-based irrigation controller to avoid overwatering your landscape. For traditional controllers, adjust the cycle time as seasons change.



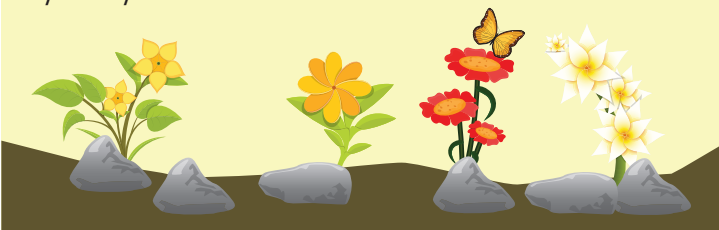
Cool's the Rule

Water when it's cooler (between 5 p.m. and 10 a.m.) to minimize water loss due to evaporation and allow water to reach plant roots.



Get Creative with Natives

Plant native, low-water-use plants in your yard.



Save the Rain

Install a rain barrel or cistern to collect rainwater and use it to water plants.
